JOSEPH SCHREINER ANNOUNCES HIS CANDIDACY FOR ILLINOIS STATE REPRESENTATIVE

LIBERTARIAN COMMITTED TO REOPENING ILLINOIS IN PROSPERITY AND HEALTH

Chicago, Illinois --- Joseph Schreiner, running as a Libertarian, announced his candidacy for state representative of Illinois's 19th district (northwest Chicago). Schreiner seeks to "Reopen Illinois in Prosperity and Health" by opposing the Pritzker/Fauci War on Illinois that has devastated the state.

Schreiner said, "COVID-19, as a so-called pandemic, is a hoax. This virus is no worse than the seasonal flu. Small and medium sized businesses, especially family businesses, have been destroyed. Other civil institutions have been wiped out. The people of Illinois are not allowed to assemble or to provide each other support. If all this were imposed by a foreign power, it would be regarded as an act of war and hostile military occupation. I want to make Illinois a state where businesses, families, community organizations and individuals can thrive. That is why I am running for state representative of the 19th district."
